

USER'S MANUAL

iVBPlayer - MP3/STORAGE/PLAYER/SEARCH-ENGINE



1. **MP3 SEARCH ENGINE TEXTBOX** - Search MP3 title from the music library by typing its full or partial name in the search textbox and the MP3 filename will be displayed alone in the list view box.
2. **MP3 PLAYER** - Used to play the selected MP3 song.
3. **MP3 PLAYER LUNCH BUTTON** - Lunch or hide MP3 PLAYER.
4. **LISTVIEW BOX** - It will display all MP3's File saved in music library when iVBPlayer is in loading mode, and when in the search mode, its only display the filename of the searched MP3 title.
5. **DRIVE/DIRECTORY EXPLORER LUNCH BUTTON** – Lunch or hide Drive/Directory explorer navigator.

- 6. MUSIC LIBRARY STORAGE BOX** - You can drag MP3 or WMA Files from your local drive and drop it on the Music Library Storage Box to save it in the Music Library Folder in your application path. Then the Sound File that has been added was populated in the List view box right after dropping it.
- 7. COPY FILE BUTTON** - Copy the selected MP3 File in the List view box to the destination path selected in the Drive/Directory Explorer.
- 8. PLAY BUTTON** - Play the selected MP3 File.
- 9. DRIVE/DIRECTORY EXPLORER** - Use to select the destination folder where the selected MP3 File save in..



- 10. POP UP MENU** - By right clicking the mouse while your pointer is in the List view Box, the POP UP MENU Show with 7 Event Category which is the Play, Stop, Copy File, Delete File, Help, About and Exit Event.

I am decided to developed this kind of software just for the replacement of iTunes program that I am using in my Internet Shop. In my usage of iTunes for almost 2 years, I was encounter some problem like.. when I am adding mp3 files in the iTunes music library and later delete that file in its original location, and try to search that file again in the search box , the filename was displayed in the list.. but the problem occurs when I try to copy or play that file, coz iTunes fail to locate because the file was deleted..

Maybe when drag and drop of mp3 files was made in iTunes music library, iTunes only save the mp3 file path and filename and not the mp3 file itself, that's why iTunes fail to locate the mp3 file when it was deleted...

This is the advantage of my developed software called iVBPlayer, because in iVBPlayer, when drag and drop of mp3 files occurred it will copy the mp3 file into iVBPlayer music library folder and it has no regards at all to the original mp3 file even if it is move, rename, or deleted at any time....iVBPlayer was designed and programmed in Visual Basic 6.0 IDE... Try to use iVBPlayer and it is for you to decide which is the better one..
